On March 16, Friday, the film, "The Immortal Life of Henrietta Lacks" will be shown at 8:00pm. This is the last film of the series of 21 years.

(2017, US film for TV, directed by George Wolfe, 93 min.) In the 1950s Henrietta Lacks, an African-American woman (Renée Elise Goldsberry) developed cervical cancer and unbeknownst to herself or her family became a pioneer for medical breakthroughs. Her cells were used to create the first immortal human cell line, now spread all over the world aiding research. After Henrietta's death, her children were raised by different family members. Rebecca Skloot (Rose Byrne) was intrigued when she heard in science class about HeLa cells and decided to research the background story. She helped write the script for this film. It was not easy for her to get the Lacks family to talk as there was much bitterness about the fact that the cells were taken without permission and that they never benefited from the breakthrough that has helped people all over the world. Eventually Rebecca gained the confidence of Deborah Lacks (Oprah Winfrey) and together they search for any information about the mother Deborah can't remember. She also is able to get some insights from Deborah's brothers Sonny (Rocky Carroll), Lawrence (John Thompson) and Day (Roger Robinson). (#429)
